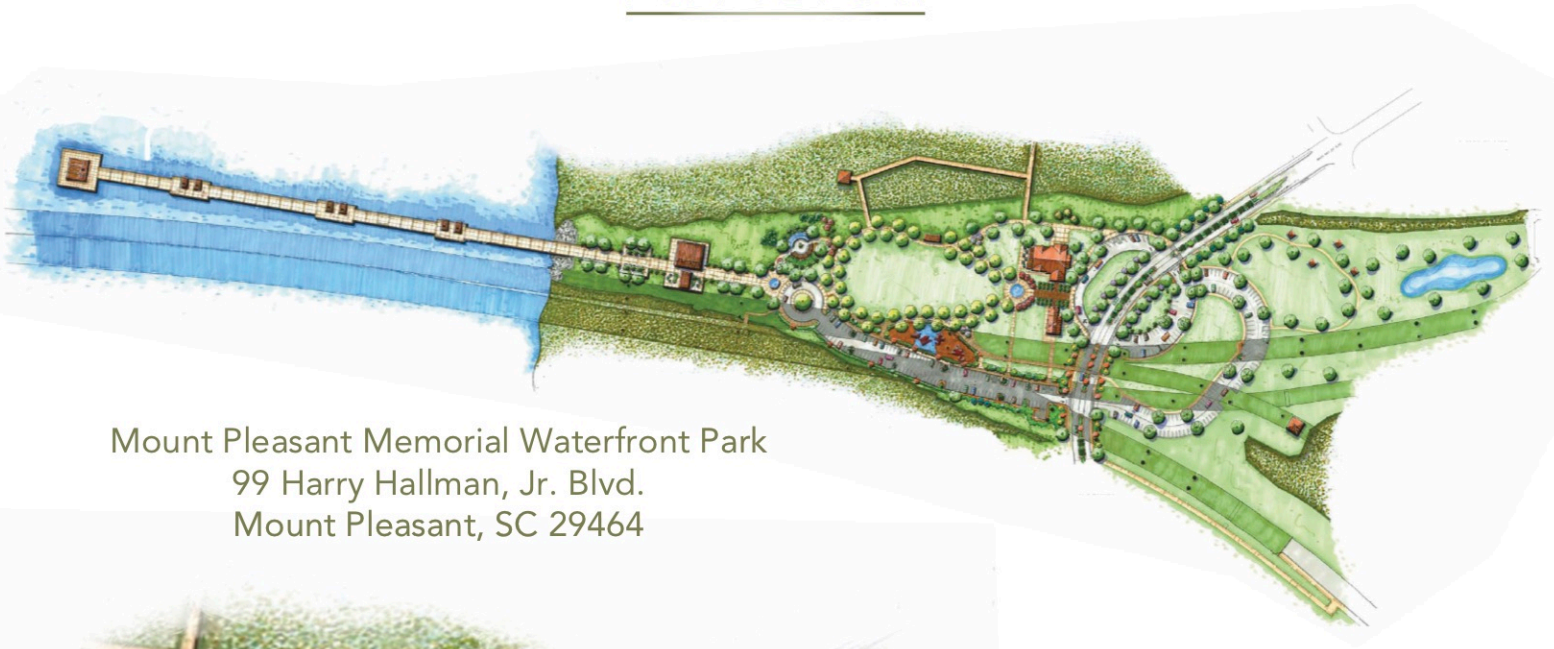

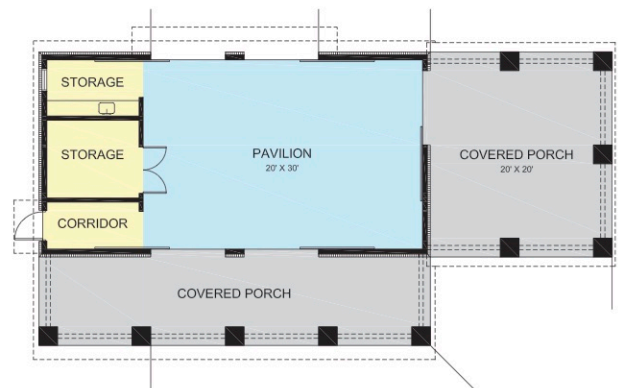

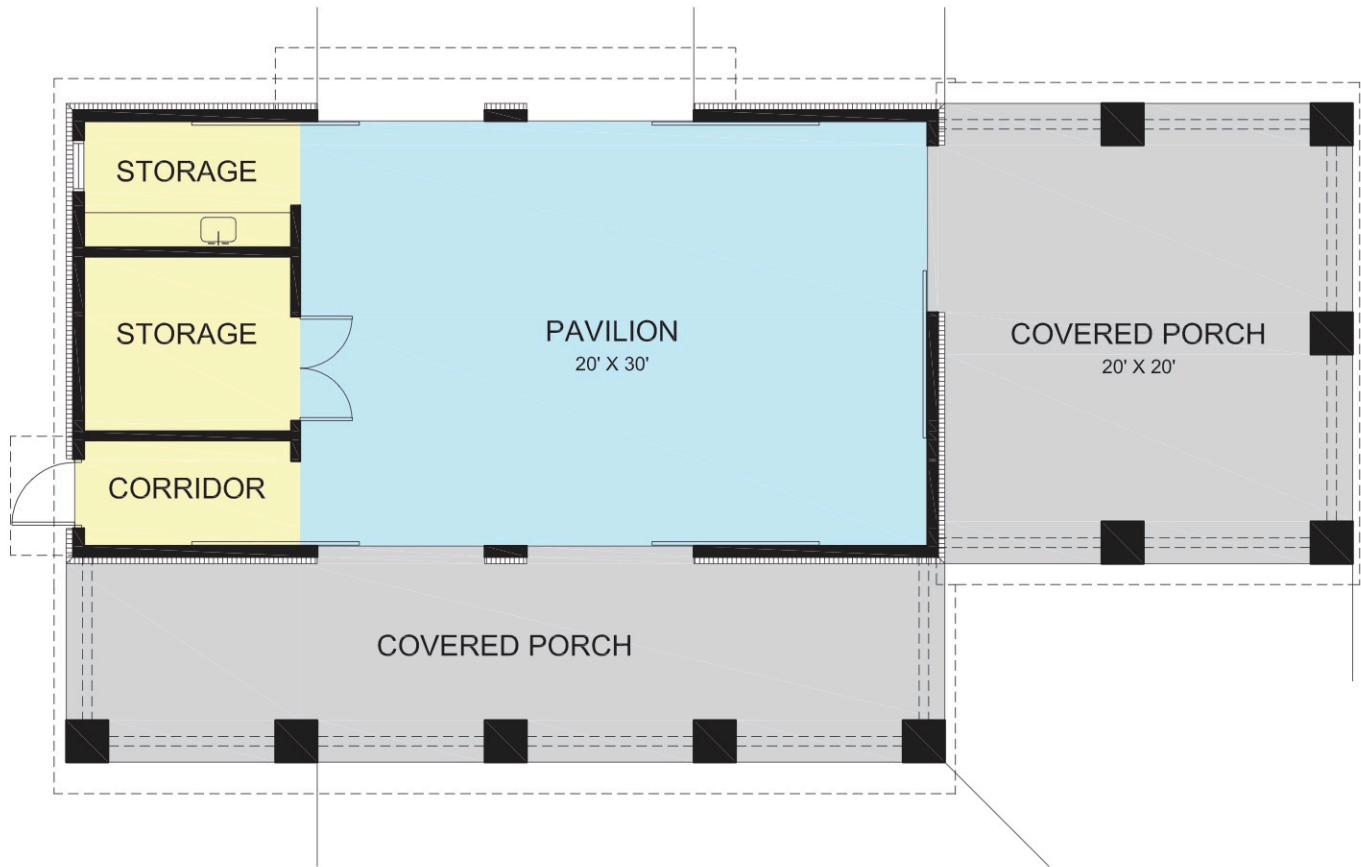
- A. Crescent Lawn

(9) 20-AMP circuits provide electricity for outdoor use

CATERING GUIDELINES

Caterers & Bar Service must provide protective mats under all active food stations and bars located indoors.

Caterers are responsible for providing trash cans and liners.

All park trash cans must be cleaned and rebagged.

Do not dump ice on landscape or in grass.

Rentals shall be broken down and stored at vendor load-in area for same night pick-up.

Floor shall be swept and spot-mopped.

Counters and sinks must be thoroughly wiped down and cleaned.

A catering representative is required to check-out with the Sweetgrass Pavilion Manager-on-Duty or the client will not receive their security deposit.
